 that wee MAMINEPOE and WAMPAGE, alias Annhook Indian propriotors of a certaine tract
 of land lying within the limitte & bounds of the pattent of the County, Town of West-
 chester, in the province of New York for a valuable consideracon & other consideracon
 us thereunto moving & having taken the advise & aprobaton of severall native Indians
 hereunder written to us in hand paid by JOHN PALMER, WILLIAM BARNES & WILLIAM RICHARD-
 SON, JOSEPH PALMER, SAMUELL PALMER & ROBERT HUESTIS, JOHN FERRIS, JOHN HUNT, & JOSEPH
 HUNT, JOSIAH HUNT, THOMAS BAXTER & EDWARD COLLIER, Trustees of the freeholders &
 commonalty of the Town of Westchester, aforesaid, the receipt whereof we do hereby
 acknowledge & therewith to be fully satisfied, contented & paid & thereof do acquitt,
 exenorate, release & discharge the said Trustees their heirs, successors & assignes
 forever have given, granted, bargained, sold, enfeoffed, released & confirmed and
 by these presents do fully, clearly & absolutly give, grant, bargaine, sell, enfeoff
 release & confirm unto the said Trustees their heirs, successors & assignes forever,
 ALL that tract of land lying on the east side of Breunxhis river, BEGINING at the
 pine trees & so compassing all the land which we the said Maminepoe & Wampage lays
 claime to untill they come to the head of Rattle Snake brook & from thence northeast
 to Mr. Pells line, so north by said Pells marked tree by Branksis rivers, TOGETHER
 with the woods, underwoods, timber, trees, waters, rivers, runs, brooke & all &
 singular the emollements, hereditaments, rights, priviledges & appurtenances there-
 unto belonging or appertaining, only reserving to our selves the priviledge of making
 use of white wood trees for our one perticular use. TO HAVE & TO HOLD the before
 recited premisses with all & every of its appurtenances unto the said Trustees their
 heirs, successors & assignes to the only proper use, benefitt & behooff of them the
 said Trustees their heirs, successors & assignes forever. AND it shall & may be
 lawfull for the said Trustees their heirs, successors & assignes from henceforth
 & forever to have, hold, use, occupie, possess & enjoy the said tract of land free
 from all incumbrances whatsoever unto the said Trustees their successors & assignes
 forever without any mannor of claime, challenge or demand of us, our heirs, execut-
 ors or administrators or any other native Indians or Christian people by, from or
 under us or any person or persons whatsoever. AND we the

Memoroneck, in ye County of Westchester, June ye fourth Anno Dominx 1702, Laid out one lott of land for John Desbrow, begining at Memoroneck river by a mapple tree markt on all four sides & from thence west thirty degrees, northerly twenty one chaines to a white oke tree markt on all four sides & from thence west ten degrees southerly three chains to a peperidge tree markt on all four sides & from thence south eleven degrees westerly to a stake markt on all four sides & from thence south thirty eight degrees, easterly fourteen chaines to a mapple markt on four sides at Sheldrake River, and then along the said river and then along the feild river to Memoroneck River to the first station. Containing fifty acres,
